BICYCLE POLICY

Purpose

To control the usage of the bicycle racks on the Muster Station platform within the moorage basin. This will ensure bicycles are not left for extended periods of time or used as a long-term bicycle storage facility. The use of the bike racks is intended primarily for daytime use while boating or attending the clubhouse.

References

6.13 The use of all wheeled transportation, motorized or not, such as gas or battery powered scooters, rollerblades, skateboards and bicycles shall not be ridden on the docks, with the sole exception of mobility aids as required by a person with a mobility impairment.

Policy

Use of bike racks:

- Any member wishing to use the bike racks on the Muster Station must first register their bicycle with the Club office and receive an annual decal that must be affixed to the bicycle
- Up to four bicycles may be registered per membership
- An agreement indicating the member will comply with the rules of the bike rack policy must be signed
- Any bicycle found on the Muster Station bikes racks without a decal may be removed at the member's expense
- All bicycles must be removed from the bike racks each night from 11:00pm to 6:00am unless registered for overnight (see below)
- Bicycles locked to railings, fence, ramps, posts, crane or any other item other than the bike racks will be removed immediately
- Bicycles may be taken on the docks and aboard the member's boat for storage on the boat. Bicycles must not be left on any dock or finger.
- Bicycles must not be ridden on the docks but may be walked to and from the moorage entrance to the member's slip

Overnight use of bike racks:

- If a member needs to store their bicycle overnight while they are out on their boat or for other approved reasons they may register their bicycle with the office for temporary overnight bike rack use
- Each period must not exceed 4 nights in a week or 8 nights in a month.

Intermediate, Junior, Honorary members and staff requiring access to the bike racks:

- May receive a bike registration decal annually from the office

- Will be required to sign an agreement indicating they will adhere by the rules and regulations of the access to the muster station and the bike rack policy
- Will not be permitted to leave their bicycles overnight

Removal of bikes from bike racks:

- Bikes left on the muster station overnight which are not registered for temporary overnight use or bikes not displaying a decal may be removed. Bikes not claimed within 3 days will be placed into an off-site storage for a period of 30 days.
- Members may reclaim bicycles which have been removed by providing staff with a description of the bicycle and may be required to provide proof of ownership.
- An administrative fee will be charged for bicycles put into storage
- Staff will have 48 hours from time of request to retrieve bicycle from the storage facility.
- Any locks left attached to the bike rack only (not securing a bike) will be removed immediately.

Disposal of unclaimed bicycles:

- Any bicycles unclaimed after 30 days will be disposed of
- The club will not be held responsible for any bikes left at the club or removed due to non-adherence of the policy
- The club will not be held responsible for any damage to the bike and/or destruction of the lock(s) due to cutting it off for removal of the bike from the racks not in compliance with the policy
