

## **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SIs)**

### **1.0 RULES**

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (2021-2024)*, the prescriptions of Sail Canada, the Notice of Race (NoR) for these series, and the Sailing Instructions for this series.

### **2.0 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 2.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted no later than one (1) hour before racing on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 8:00 PM on the day before it will take effect.

### **3.0 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS**

- 3.1 NoR and SIs updates will be posted to the official on-line notice board at [kelownayachtclub.com/racing/open-racing/](http://kelownayachtclub.com/racing/open-racing/). An alternate bulletin board will be kept updated on the Regatta Network page.
- 3.2 [Discretionary Penalty – DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on Channel 72.
- 3.3 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio, channel 72.
- 3.4 The race office is located at KYC Statistician's Office.

### **4.0 CODE OF CONDUCT**

- 4.1 [Discretionary Penalty - DP] Competitors and support persons shall comply with reasonable requests from race officials.

### **5.0 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE**

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on a flagpole located on the Commodores dock.
- 5.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in Race Signals AP.

### **6.0 SCHEDULE OF RACES**

- 6.1 As posted on-line at [kelownayachtclub.com/racing/open-racing/](http://kelownayachtclub.com/racing/open-racing/).
- 6.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal for all races is 6:00 PM.
- 6.3 Races will be started as described in RRS 26, except that an Attention signal, consisting of a series of sounds, may be made one minute before the first warning signal.

## 7.0 CLASS FLAGS

7.1 Fleet Classes are pending registration and tentatively defined as follows

Fleet 1	PHRF	To Be Determined
S525	ODR	One Design Racing
Fleet 3	PHRF	To Be Determined

7.2 The Fleet 1 Class flag Numeral pennant 1.

7.3 S525 Class flag is the Numeral pennant 2.

7.4 The Fleet 3 Class flag Numeral pennant 3.

## 8.0 RACING AREA

8.1 SI Addendum A shows the location of the racing area.

## 9.0 COURSES

9.1 All marks to be left to port. X denotes a gate between X mark and a staff displaying an orange flag on the signal vessel when X is displayed mid-course. This gate must be crossed in the direction travelled from the previous mark.

9.2 No later than the warning signal, the race committee signal vessel will display the course to be raced.

9.3 The course will be displayed at the stern of the RC boat as a series of letters.

## 10.0 MARKS

10.1 The following marks can be rounding marks: A, B, C, D, and E.

10.2 X is a gate defined as a line between X mark and a staff displaying an orange flag on the signal vessel.

## 11.0 THE START

11.1 The starting line is between a staff displaying an orange flag on the signal vessel and mark X.

11.2 There will be a rolling start. Fleet 3 will start first followed by Fleet 1 and then Fleet 2.

11.3 A boat must keep clear of the start area by 50 meters unless the warning signal for her start sequence has been made.

## 12.0 THE FINISH

12.1 The finishing line is between the blue flag mounted to the signal boat and the course side of Mark Y.

12.2 If the race committee is absent when a boat finishes, she shall report her finishing time, and her position in relation to nearby boats, to the race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.

### 13.0 TIME LIMITS

13.1 The Race Time Limit (see RRS 35) is shown in the table below.

### 14.0 HEARING REQUESTS

14.1 The protest time limit is 60 minutes after the last boat finishes the last race of the day.

14.2 Hearing request forms are available from the race office at Statisticians Office.

14.3 Notices will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses. Hearings will be held in a protest room, as determined by the RO, beginning at the time posted.

14.4 RRS 62.2(a) and 66.2(a) do not apply.

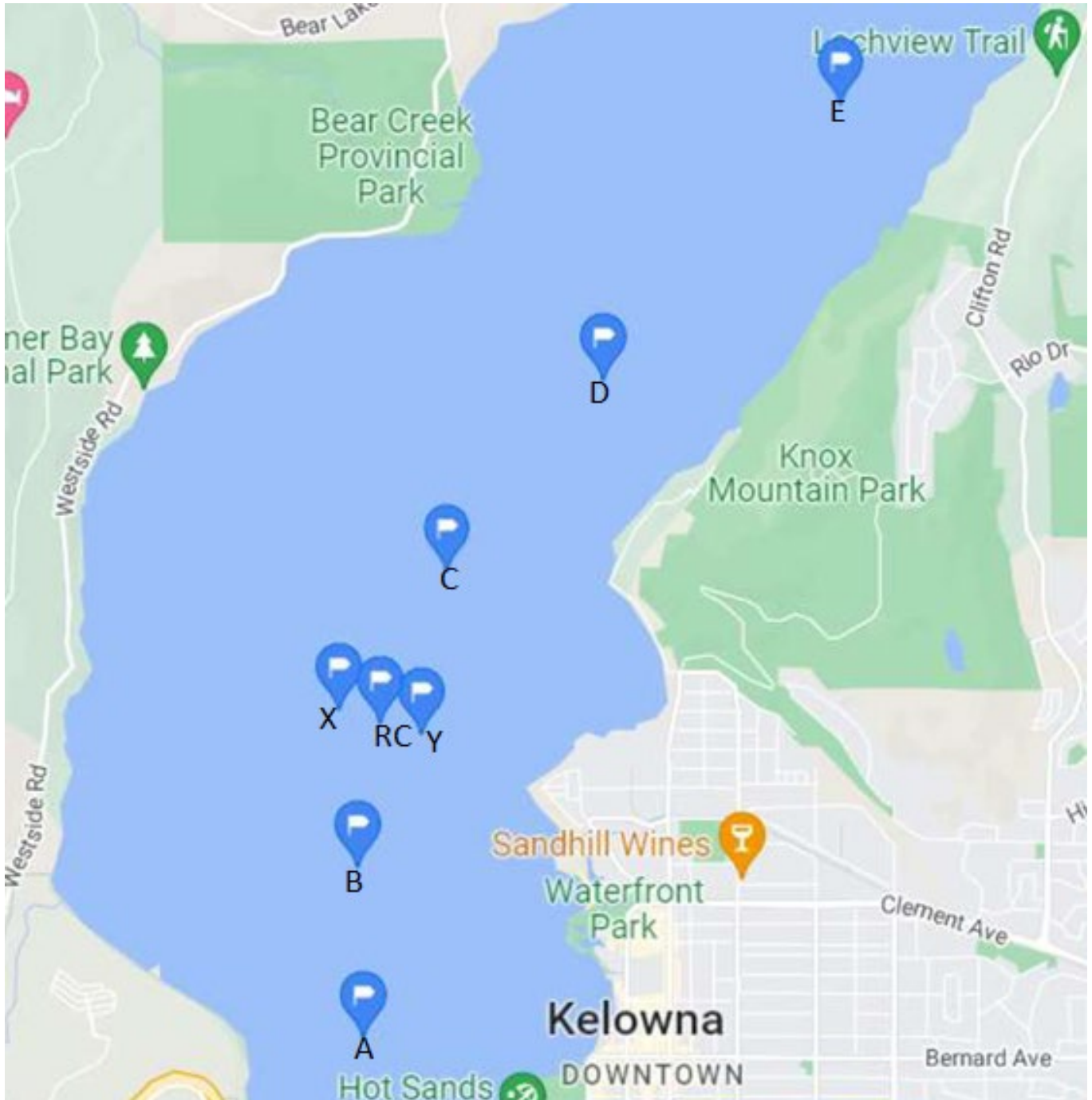
