



Kelowna Yacht Club Okanagan Women's Regatta July 4 - 6, 2025 NOTICE of RACE (NoR)

#### ORGANIZING AUTHOURITY

The Organizing Authority (OA) for this event is the Kelowna Yacht Club, located at 1370 Water Street, Kelowna BC.

### 1.0 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (2025-2028),
- 1.2 *Sail Canada Prescriptions* to *The* Racing *Rules of Sailing* apply, available online at kelownayachtclub.com/racing/race-management-resources/.
- 1.3 PHRF-BC Rules apply, available online at bcsailing.ca.

### 2.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing Instructions will be available online after 12 p.m. (noon) on or before June 27, 2025, at <a href="kelownayachtclub.com/event/okanagan-womens-regatta/">kelownayachtclub.com/event/okanagan-womens-regatta/</a>.
- 2.2 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be posted to the official online notice board <u>kelownayachtclub.com/event/okanagan-womens-regatta/</u>.

# 3.0 COMMUNICATION

3.1 The online official notice board is located at <u>kelownayachtclub.com/event/okanagan-womens-regatta/</u>.

- 3.2 [Discretionary Penalty DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on Channel 72.
- 3.3 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio, channel 72.
- 3.4 [DP]While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

# 4.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all keel boats that hold a valid 2025 PHRF -BC certificate, and
  - 4.1.1. Are comprised of all female crew, or
  - 4.1.2. All female crew plus one coach (male coach permitted) below.
- 4.2 The PHRF-BC rating system with time-on-time calculations apply.
- 4.3 Classes are defined as follows:

Fleet 1	PHRF	Women Only
Fleet 2	PHRF	Women plus Coaches

- 4.4 Registration is available online at <u>kelownayachtclub.com/event/okanagan-womens-regatta/</u>. Registration closes July 5, 2025, at 10 a.m. PDT.
- 4.5 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

# 6.0 SCHEDULE

#### Check-In:

Friday, July 4 from 5 p.m. - 7 p.m. PDT at Kelowna Yacht Club Grand Banquet Room Racing:

Saturday: Scheduled time for the first warning signal on Saturday, July 5, 2025, is 10 a.m. PDT with no race starting later than 4 p.m. PDT.

Sunday: Scheduled time for the first warning signal on Sunday, July 6, 2025, is 9:30 a.m. PDT with no race starting later than 2:30 p.m. PDT.

# Social Events:

A detailed social schedule will be circulated closer to the date of the event.

# 7.0 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 7.1 Boats may be inspected at any time.
- 7.2 Transport Canada required safety equipment must be on board at all times and may be inspected at any time.

# 8.0 VENUE

8.1 Courses to be sailed will be on Okanagan Lake in the vicinity of the Kelowna Yacht Club located at 1370 Water St., Kelowna, B.C.

#### 9.0 COURSES

9.1 The course will be a combination of permanent KYC marks A, B, C, D, and E.

#### 10.0 SCORING

- 10.1 The low point scoring system of Appendix A of the RRS will apply.
- 10.2 For all classes:
  - a) Each fleet will be scored separately
  - b) One or more completed races will constitute a series
  - c) When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores
  - d) When five (5) to seven (7) races have been completed, a boat's score for the series will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
  - e) When eight (8) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of their race scores excluding their two worst scores.

#### 11.0 PRIZES

- 11.1 Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each fleet.
- 11.2 A combined fleet overall trophy will be awarded by calculating the lowest point score as follows: total of low point scoring system received by a boat for all races in its class, divided by the number of boats in its class. Discards are in accordance with 10.2 c), d), e), above.

#### **12.0 SAFETY**

- 12.1 A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.
- 12.2 A boat may be requested to assist another vessel as directed by the Race Officer of the Day.
- 12.3 [DP] When instructed by a race official on the water, a boat shall proceed to a designated area for inspection.

#### 13.0 RISK STATEMENT

- 13.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks.

  These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform, and fatigue resulting in an increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes.
- 13.2 The organizing authority, management, Board of Directors and volunteers, will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in

conjunction with or prior to, during or after this race series.

#### 14.0 INSURANCE

14.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$2,000,000 per incident or the equivalent. The organizing Authority does not accept responsibility for verifying that a competitor holds valid insurance.

# 15.0 ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

15.1 All regatta participants are requested to adhere to the Kelowna Yacht Club Environmental Policy including: eliminating the release of contaminants to the water column, both directly and indirectly, minimize the release of pollutants to the atmosphere, avoid contamination of the ground, adopt waste reduction, reuse and recycling strategies, optimize energy and water conservation, promote good environmental practices to all parties, abide by, and, where possible, exceed the requirements of all relevant legislation.

# 16.0 MOORAGE AND CLUB ACCESS

16.1 If temporary moorage is required at Kelowna Yacht Club, a Reciprocal Moorage Request Form, located online at kelownayachtclub.com, must be completed. Access to the Kelowna Yacht Club and marina is by keycard only. Reciprocal Moorage vessels for Regattas will have a temporary key card activated as a part of the Regatta Fees.

Additional key cards can be obtained at the Kelowna Yacht Club Reception desk from 9 a.m. -7 p.m. PDT on Friday, July 4, 2025, or starting at 9 a.m. PDT on Saturday, July 5, 2025. Key cards activation is \$10.00. A new permanent key card can be purchased for a fee of \$10.00 per key card. Activation is required with new key cards.


