4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 4.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed from a flagpole situated on the western edge of the Commodore's Dock. When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in Race Signals AP.

7 THE COURSES

- 7.2 The course will be displayed at the stern of the RC boat as a series of letters.

8 MARKS

- 8.2 All marks to be left to port. X denotes a gate between X mark and a staff displaying an orange flag on the signal vessel when X is displayed mid-course. This gate must be crossed in the direction travelled from the previous mark.

The following marks can be rounding marks: A, B, C, D, and E.

9 THE START

9.2 The starting line is between a staff displaying an orange flag on the signal vessel and mark X.

9.3 A boat must keep clear of the start area by 50 meters unless the warning signal for her start sequence has been made.

11 THE FINISH

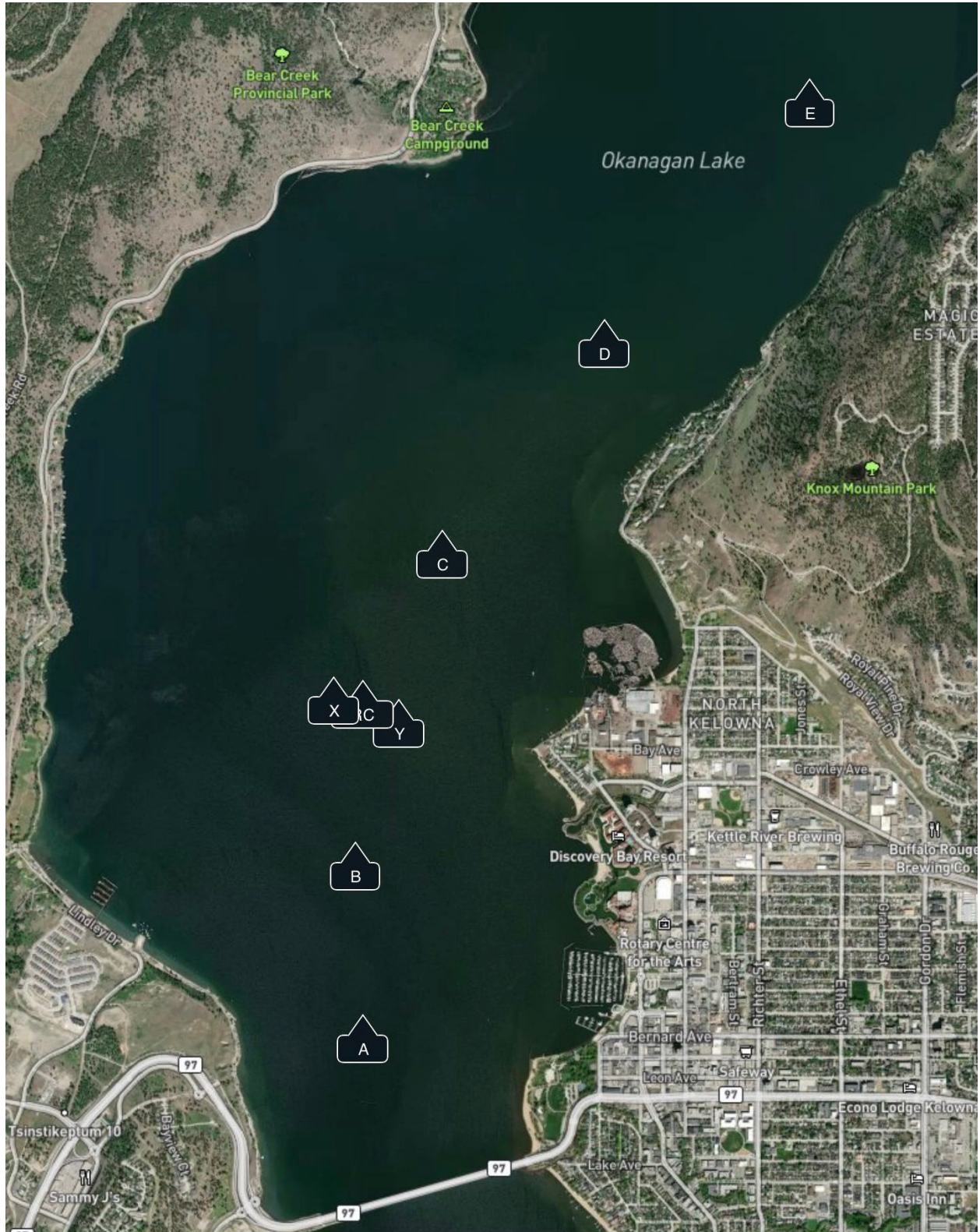
The finishing line is between the blue flag mounted to the signal boat and the course side of Mark Y.

If the Race Committee is absent when a boat finishes, she shall report her finishing time, and her position in relation to nearby boats, to the race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.
