Following the gale force winds that occurred yesterday, we brought in the team from Shoreline for further inspection of the effect on the docks. They have been out in the basin all day re-enforcing the main dock where it had started to crack and move last night. The dock walkway is secure, with decking replaced for safe passage and the water has been turned back on. There will be more work to do next week, and then some discussion can be had for future planning in the area where movement occurs between our two current dock systems. In the mean time, please watch your step if you are in the basin as work continues and boards have been temporarily secured.

With the water levels so low this time of year, I would like to advise our mooring members with slips on A/B/C or D dock to be very aware of the depth, and if you require any assistance, please call myself or our Dockmaster, Bassam, at 778-215-5473.
