We are looking for a CANSail instructor who is passionate and knowledgeable about the sport and dedicated to providing safe and fun instruction for young sailors. Our ideal candidate is a good team player and able to collaborate with fellow instructors but is also capable of working independently running their own lessons. Responsibilities:

- Teach Wet Feet, Go! Day Camp, CANSail Programs and Private/Group Lessons
- Coach in a professional manner
- Provide ongoing feedback to participants, including progress reports, Sail Canada checklists updates, and end of session interviews
- Disseminate regular communications to participants and parents
- Submit a curriculum plan and daily lesson plans
- Provide supervision during participants arrival and departure
- Participate in daily staff meetings
- Perform daily opening and closing duties, maintenance and cleanliness of sailboat fleet, coach boat fleet, coaching equipment, instructional spaces, and physical plant
- Provide an inclusive, welcoming, and flexible learning environment for all participants
